Also, on the meeting the reflection was done on the following points:

- a. Increase number of new FNC members
- b. Update of paid and unpaid membership
- c. FNC Banner Trustee Capt (Retd) Ram Pun provided the approved design General Secretary, Maha Rai to measure and design in Photoshop for the image resolution
- d. FNC & FNCC Chairty Commission Annual Accounts Report for 2022-2023. General Secretary & Treasurer has submitted the Accountant under the Supervision of Trustee Capt (Retd) Ram Pun (cc to Chairman, Jhapindra Thapa) in July. Accounts will report to the Charity Commission probably by the end of September and will be available in public domain.

Meeting consensually agreed to provide the hard copies of members list and meeting minutes at the Folkestone Nepalese Community Centre which was suggested by the Trustee Capt (Retd) Ram Pun.

2. Financial update by Treasure and General Secretary, and the change detail of the name of the bank:

- a. The meeting consensually agreed to change the name of the bank account from The Folkestone Gurkha/Nepalese to Folkestone Nepalese Community (FNC) to be consistent while reporting to the Charity Commission Annual Account Report as suggested in above 1(d).
- b. The meeting assigned General Secretary, Maha Rai, and Treasurer, Bikram Rai, to procced with the Bank for the change of the name of the business as mentioned above 2(a).
- c. Treasurer, Bikram Rai, Reported the main account with unrestricted balance of £29,426.96 (see attached financial statement -1, which was available to members only at the meeting).

- **9.** Chairman Final Remarks: Chairman, Jhapindra Thapa closed the meeting by thanking all the attending members, executive committee members and specially the board of Trustees and Advisors for their support and helping the committee & meeting to have a consensus decision on every agenda.
