HELD AT FOLKESTONE NEPALESE COMMUNITY (FNC) CENTRE ON SUNDAY 23 JNE 2024**

1	<p><b>Opening Remarks.</b> The meeting was held at 1500 hrs. on Sun 23 Jun 2024 at the FNC Centre. The Chairman, Capt. (Retd) Ram Bahadur Pun, officially opened the 9th Executive Committee's first Quarterly Meeting thanking all those in attendance and authorised the General Secretary to proceed with the meeting's agenda.</p> <p>The meeting took a moment to recognise these obituaries from the Chairman, where the Chairman, on behalf of community, extended the condolences to the mourning family and laid a wreath at the funeral services.</p> <p>a. The late CSgt Chandraman Tamang, service number 21149074 from ½ GR, aged 86, peacefully passed away on March 17, 2024. The funeral was conducted on April 17, 2024, Former Secretary Trustee Mr. Chitra Tamang coordinated the funeral on behalf of FNC. Members of the FNC generously donated £1603.00 on a voluntary basis, and a wake service took place at the FNC Centre.</p> <p>b. The late CSgt Surje Prasad Tamang, service number 21158547 from 10 GR, aged 76, peacefully passed away on 29 Mar 2024. The Viewing service at All Soul Church Hall &amp; repatriation to Nepal was organized on 19 Apr 2024. Trustee Rajen Limbu coordinated on behalf of the FNC, and the wake service was held in the FNC Centre.</p> <p>c. The late Mr. Padam Bahadur Rana, service number 21151980 from 6 GR, aged 81, peacefully passed away on 6 May 2024 and the Funeral Service was organized by the FNC under the coordination of Trustee / Former Chair Mr. Jhapindra Thapa on 30 May 2024 and the wake service took place at the FNC Centre. Members of the FNC are requested to donate on a voluntary basis to support the bereaved family (later confirmed £2224.50).</p> <p>d. The late Mr. Madan Bahadur Rai, service number 21155661 from 7 GR, aged 79, peacefully passed away on 24 May 2024 and the Funeral Service took place on 17 June 2024 and the FNC member Mr. Subash Limbu liaised for the FNC. Members of the FNC are requested to donate on a voluntary basis to support the bereaved family - donations in progress.</p> <p>e. The late Bedraj Kharti peacefully passed away on 30 Mar 2024. His body was repatriated to Nepal on 28 Jun 2024, received by deceased patents in Nepal on 29 Jun 2024. Repatriation was coordinated by the Chairman/Gen Sec. A total of £8120.88p was donated by the FNC members and other Nepalese Communities to meet the repatriation cost of the Late Khatri to Nepal. It cost FNC £5490.00p for the payment of repatriation cost to Sterry funeral Service. Hence, this left FNC with surplus of £2630.00p, which meeting decided to split between two parties in a ratio of 50% (£1315.44p) to decease's ex-wife/3 yrs. old daughter and 50% (£1315.44p) to decease's parents in Nepal as welfare support to them.</p>	All

**2. Committee Members’ Reports.** The following have updated the meeting:

a. **Gen Sec Report.** The Gen Sec read out the extracts from previous meeting for the attention of all those present in the meeting highlighting the dates of previous meeting held as shown:

- (1) Sunday, 24 Mar 2024, General Convention: Election of the 9th Executive Committee.
- (2) First Meeting of the Executive Committee on Thursday, 28 Mar 2024: Trustees and Advisors nominations.
- (3) Friday, 10 May 2024, FNC Post Nepalese New Year Celebration Meeting – minutes published online.

b. **Treasurer’s Update/Financial Statement.** The Treasurer and Gen Sec/Centre Manager informed the meeting that FNC has two bank accounts; FNC Main Account and FNC Centre account and gave their updates on FNC bank balance of both accounts, as of 23 Jun 2024, as stated below:

- (1) The FNC's Main Account Statement, detailing the account's balance of £38,897.08 of unrestricted fund, was submitted by Treasurer Mr. Bikram Rai and is included in Annex A.
- (2) The FNC Centre’s Account Statement, detailing the account’s balance of £33,065.81 of restricted and unrestricted was presented by the General Secretary / Centre Manger. The detail of the fund as of that period is as follows:

(3) Regarding Account reporting, both the Chairman and the General Secretary provided updates on the secured funding for operating the FNC Centre, as detailed below:

- (a) The FNC Centre has secured funding of £233,626 from the Community Fund National Lottery for a period of three years, starting from July 1, 2024, and ending on June 31, 2027. These funds will cover the salary of the center's staff and operational expenses. However, to continue operating at its present scale, the center needs to obtain additional funding totaling £104,405.83 over these three years.

**After Note:** The Chairman thanked the treasurer and Gen Sec/Centre Manager for keeping up to date records of account and requested them to continue excellent bookkeeping of the accounts. Statement of accounts presented above were unanimously approved by the meeting.

An updated FNC FOE as of 02 Jul 2024 has already been circulated within the FNC on 04 Jul 2024 via E-Mail/Viber, copy of which is attached at Annex B.</p> <p>Advisor, Major (Retd) Deb Pun also informed the meeting of upcoming events being coordinated by Senior Citizen coordinator Capt. (Retd) Bishnu Singh for the FNC senior citizens as shown:</p> <p>Kent County Show visit – Fri, 05 Jul 2024 Annual Gathering at the FNC Centre – Sat, 20 Jul 2024</p> <p><b>After Note:</b> The Chairman requested all members to note the forthcoming FNC events on their dairy and to make every effort to attend them.</p>	All
5.	<p><b>Teej Celebration.</b> As Teej is being the most desired celebration for the FNC ladies, FNC Ladies Coordinator, Mrs. Indria Rai, and her team have decided to hold the FNC Teej Celebration on Friday 30 Aug 2024 at Lemon Leaf. The celebration will be held on self-funded basis. Thus, all FNC ladies are kindly requested for their participation in this celebration. Tickets are already out and on sale now at Nepali Local Shops. The quotation for one plaque was £17.79 each.</p> <p>b. <b>FNC Welcome Banners.</b> For use at the Nepalese New Year Celebration and other events by the FNC.</p> <p><b>After Note:</b> Meeting unanimously approved the proposals, selected the designs and agreed to purchase 50 x Plaques and order banners from Nepal, which expected to arrive from Nepal soon.</p>	All
7.	<p><b>FNC Centre Bimonthly Cleaning.</b> The Chairman propose to introduce bimonthly deep cleaning of the FNC Centre to familiarize members with the center's facilities as well as to ensure Centre is kept clean, tidy and hazard free to meet the obligation of KCC tenancy agreements for all users.</p> <p><b>After note:</b> The proposal was agreed by all. 8.	<p><b><u>Karaoke/Tombola Night.</u></b> Trustee Mr. Rajen Limbu suggested to hold Karaoke/Tombola night at the Centre to promote social gatherings and to help members get acquainted.</p> <p><b><u>After Note:</u></b> Meeting accepted the idea and plan to hold the tombola night as pilot recreational program soon. Any volunteers who is willing to coordinate the event are requested to contact the Chairman/Gen Sec.</p>	All
9.	<p><b><u>Any Other Business (AOB)</u></b></p> <p>1. <b><u>Attendance/Dress Code.</u></b> The Chairman emphasis the active participation of Executive Committee Members, Trustees, Advisors and All Members to the FNC program/meetings as their active participation help to uplift the atmosphere of the event as well as exchange ideas and information to make right decisions over the key issues for the betterment of the FNC. He also kindly requested to adhere to the dress code as prescribed at event instructions by all members. Too casual or inappropriate attire can create an unprofessional atmosphere, which can undermine the importance of the event and negatively impact the overall image of the FNC and its members.</p> <p>2. <b><u>Chain of Command.</u></b> The Chairman further stressed the importance of social engagement at the Centre and adhering to the FNC's Chain of Command for smooth operation of the FNC. He stated that it is crucial for all our members to understand the reporting line and adhere to the Chain of Command to ensure effective decision making, accountability and for smooth functioning of the FNC avoiding duplication of work. Hence, Chairman has issued a FNC Chain of Command Policy (connect chairman e-mail of 30 Jun 2024) for the information and compliance of all FNC Members in the future.</p> <p>3. <b><u>Food Management Plan/Pent Farm Project.</u></b> The Food and Beverage Secretary, Mr. Chandra Shai, presented the management plan for the upcoming event Food and Drinks at the FNC's meeting, which was noted. Additionally, his concerning the Pent Farm project and the issue of water scarcity- the General Secretary detailed the objectives of the project, and the Chairman is set to visit the project soon.</p> <p>4. <b><u>FNC Viber Net for Donation Collection.</u></b> The Assistant Cultural Secretary, Mr. Ganesh Pun, highlighted the need to differentiate between FNC Social news delivery and Donation collection for condolences on FNC's Viber platform to ease off overloading of information. Therefore, he suggested opening a new FNC Viber net for exclusive use of donation collection only to avoid overloading of information on FNC normal Viber site, an idea which the meeting recognized and praised. Gen Sec is to investigate the possibility of opening a separate Viber site for the donation collection only under the heading of "FNC Donation Collection Site".</p> <p>5. <b><u>Removal of E-Mail ID/Contacts of Members from FNC Social network.</u></b> Advisor Mr. Dhan Gurung advised that the Committee to seriously consider for removal of E-Mail ID/Contacts of members who are no longer residing in Folkestone region for safeguarding of Data Protection Law. The meeting acknowledged his concern and Gen Sec will arrange removal of E-Mail ID/Contacts of members who are no longer residing in Folkestone region from FNC Social Networks soon.</p> <p>6. <b><u>Trustees Comments.</u></b> They reminded the Committee to ensure that the Annual Return to Charity Commission is submitted on time.</p> <p>7. <b><u>Appreciation.</u></b> Secretary Mr. Lingja Rai and all the present in the meeting appreciated the hard work of all committee members/Trustee/Advisors over the past months and particularly Chairman's leadership in skillfully leading the FNC by handling the issue of welfare case of Late Berdej Khatri and Committee in securing funding for operation of FNC Centre for another 3 years with all the commitment and support of FNC Members.</p>	<p>All</p> <p>All</p> <p>Gen Sec/ All</p> <p>Gen Sec/ All</p>
