WHY CONDUCT OUTREACH SESSIONS?

✦ Vital for raising awareness and increasing participation

✦ Especially among high - risk and under served groups

✦ They help overcome barriers to access

✦ Promote early detection

✦ Improve survival rates by ensuring more people get screened



THE DOVER OUTREACH CENTRE:

The Homeless Community



People experiencing homelessness face much higher rates of smoking related harm



Smoking cessation advisors offered tailored support and practical strategies for quitting smoking



We provided on-site lung health assessments and information about the risks of lung cancer



By bringing these health services directly to the centre, the outreach session helped ensure that vulnerable individuals could access crucial screening and support in a familiar and welcoming environment

THE CANTERBURY PROGRAMME LAUNCH: OUTCOMES



- Mild emphysema and kidney cyst
- Mild emphysema and Mild CAC x2
- Mild emphysema, Mild CAC, Thoracic spondylosis, bilateral pleural calcified plaques and hepatic cysts
- Mild emphysema x2
- Mild emphysema, Mild CAC and thoracic spondylosis
- Mild emphysema, thoracic spondylosis and old mild anterior wedging of L2 vertebral body
- Mild emphysema, Moderate CAC and thoracic spondylosis
- Mild emphysema, small type 1 hiatal hernia and few bilateral renal cortical cysts
- Mild emphysema, thoracic spondylosis and hepatic cysts
- Mild emphysema, Mild CAC, thoracic spondylosis and hepatic cysts

THE NEPALESE COMMUNITY CENTRE:

Nepalese community in Folkestone



Outreach day 06/02/25 CT scan 20/02/25

- ◆ Assessments – 14
- ◆ Eligible for CT – 6
- ◆ Mild emphysema - 2
- ◆ Mild emphysema and CAC - 1
- ◆ Anterior mediastinum lesion for CT in 6 months - 1
- ◆ ILD and emphysema referred to respiratory - 1
- ◆ Mild emphysema and thoracic spondylosis - 1

The culturally sensitive approach, supported by bilingual advisers, ensured language was not a barrier.

The session's success underscores the need for ongoing, tailored outreach to meet diverse community needs

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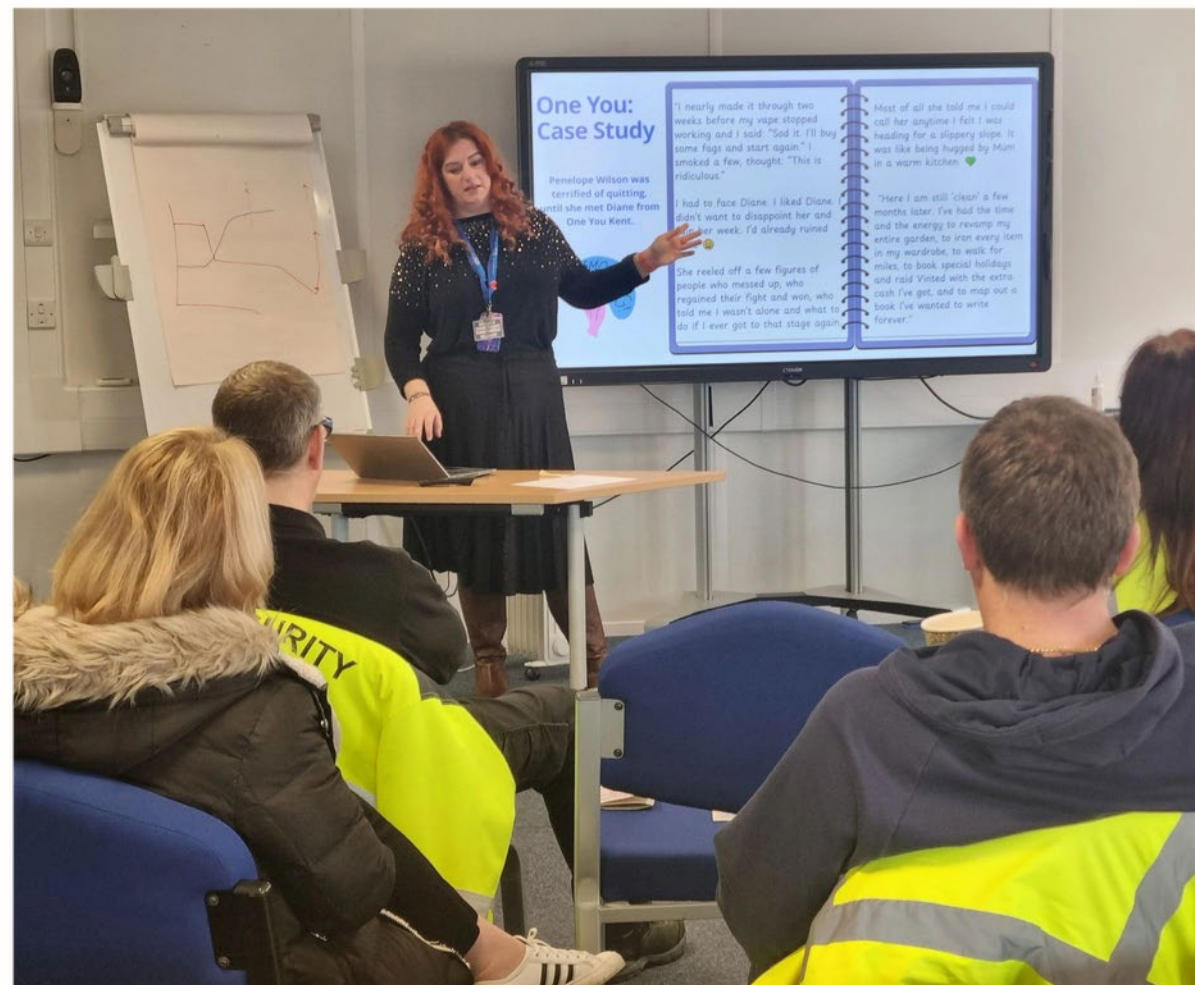
